#### Chair's Remarks:

- Bishop Oulton officially extended congratulations to Dean Mary Irwin-Gibson on her election as Bishop of Diocese of Montreal. Consecration will be held at the Cathedral in Montreal on September 29 at 7:00pm. The Parish Advisory Committee (PAC) is in place and have begun their meetings. A farewell will be held for Dean Mary on Aug 9 at St. George's after the 10:30am service. Dean Mary's last service to preach at St. George's Cathedral will be Aug 16. Bishop Oulton expressed thanks for her six years in the Diocese; she has brought a great deal of care, love, and deep spirit to the Diocese. The people of Montreal will be blessed.
- Bishop Oulton visited Canon Chris Carr today and took the sacraments. Chris is currently in palliative care, is comfortable but failing. Prayers are continued for him and the whole family
- Vacancies: Bishop Oulton advised that Rev Tim Kuhlmann of the Parish of Land O Lakes will be finishing at the end of June; and Rev Barbara Robinson of St. Paul's Brockville will be leaving the parish at the end of July. Interim Priests will be announced in July. Ven Brad Smith deconsecrated the church in Ompah on Sun June 21.

Finance Committee Alex Pierson

Unaudited Statement of Revenue, Expenses and Surplus to May 21, 2015

Most items are in line with this time of year; mainly on track. Receivable slightly up from last year. Incoming cash flow is about \$45,000 less from last year.

Alex spoke to the **2016 Budget Development** brochure covering Objectives, Regional Sessions that were held June 2, 2015 (some concern over lack of greater attendance from churches), Objectives of Regional Meetings and Key Topics in all 3 Sessions.

A key message and common theme seems to be for the Diocese to provide Facilitation, and Connection; a Conversational and Relational role for Diocese and Parishes; a need to focus and align with the Ministry Task Force; and a need to be Engaged and Involved.

The Diocesan Centre, Church Bookroom, Camp Hyanto, Cathedral, Wider Church were detailed individually of likes, dislikes, connections and concerns, alternatives, and sharing and understanding.

A Chosen Topic from each Deanery was **Parish Covenants**; there was clear support but with governance and process to be put in place.

**Children, Youth and Young Families** was another chosen topic; a reminder that this was a key part of the Ministry Task Force report. There is a need to reach out through choirs, sports teams and other means, with an opportunity and need for Social Media – or is there, as expressed as another view point by council.

**Ministry to Seniors and Retired** and **Community Engagement** (community engagement with the City) was noted. Strong support was recorded for **Communications**.

Further topics were Alternate Income/Revenue Sources, Stewardship & Congregational Development.

Alex Pierson continued to review the Revenue and Expense Inputs, a <u>Very Preliminary</u> view, showing the requests through income and expenditures on a graph, the result being approx \$300,000 shortfall.

Discussion then led into the budget process and what route we can take to enable the Diocese to include and provide the variable programs; or where reductions need to take place. What is sustainable? Valuable funding suggestions were put forward by Council members, with comparisons and expertise. Lengthy discussion pursued. A number of constraints with the budget doesn't allow expenses toward the benefit of the parishes. Finance Committee requested that members complete the 2016 Budget Guidance circulated at the meeting. This feedback will enable Finance Committee to prioritize the budget and determine the scope, then develop budget proposal for September Synod Council meeting for next review and direction. Further Regional Budget consultation sessions will be in October 2015, for final approval of Budget by Synod Council at October or November meeting 2015.
