Our Keynote Speaker, **Rev. Dr. David Neelands** is the retired Dean of Divinity at Trinity College, University of Toronto. **The Very Reverend Shane A. D. Parker** is Dean of the Anglican Diocese of Ottawa and Rector of Christ Church Cathedral, Ottawa. Dean Parker has trained in mediation and reconciliation, and is an associate member of the Ontario Association of Family Mediators. He has established a close connection with the Community of the Cross of Nails, Coventry Cathedral’s ministry of reconciliation. Dean Parker will examine all aspects of **Reconciliation** in the Anglican context.



**Rev. Bram Pearce** served in the Salvation Army for 10 years in a number of different ministries throughout Canada. He was ordained an Anglican priest in 2013 and served five years as the incumbent of St. John’s, Bath. He is currently the incumbent of St. Peter’s, Collins Bay and is working towards his Doctorate of Ministry at San Francisco Theological Seminary. In his workshop on **Contemplative Prayer**, Rev. Pearce will make concrete and practical suggestions for developing centering prayer in our own lives.
